### DATES

### FEES

Fees for PMC will be:

Adults - \$525.00 **until June 1**; \$550.00 after June 1; Youth (aged 5-12): \$300.00 anytime.

We have to iron out a few more details before registration opens. Our next board meeting is February 11, and registration won't be open before then. The next summary will have a date for registration.

## Support Update

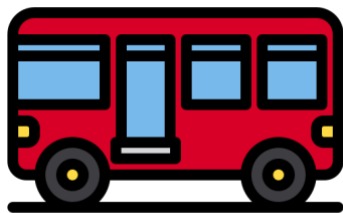
We promised information on how we are responding to the incident on the last night of camp.

The "Caring Community Initiative" (CCI) is a small subcommittee of the PMC Board. CCI has met 3 times already to review the incident, our response, and the resources available to us. The group is now moving into the action phase, starting with the foundational documents that guide everything we do at PMC. These edits will be discussed February 11, in preparation for registration.

As we progress, we will have specific recommendations in other areas. We have lots of ideas for things we might do. The recommendations will be ready in March/April, with the goal of having most things in place for camp 2023. Click [here](#) to see the full list of ideas.
