

# **Packing Checklist for Presbyterian Music Camp 2025 - Kintail**

**Remember to pack the following items:**

## **All Campers have available as you arrive**

	<b>Additional info for staff ie. health</b>
	Lanyard for Nametag (string/gimp will be provided)

## **Staff have available as you arrive**

	<b>Police Checks (if required)</b>

## **Clothing for all weather conditions**

	Sneakers or other sturdy shoes
	Rainproof shoes/boots and raincoat
	Warm jacket/coat
	Swim suit and towel
	Water Shoes (lake is stony)
	Sun protection (hat, long sleeves, sunscreen)
	Warm socks

## **Bedding**

	Fitted sheet for your mattress
	Sleeping bag OR sheet & blanket
	Pillow and case
	Additional padding for mattress (if desired – your mattress might be too hard for you)

## **Personal care items**

	Shower shoes
	Towel, face cloth, soap
	Toothpaste, Toothbrush
	Shampoo, Conditioner
	Hand sanitizer
	Make-up/shaving mirror

Many folks like to bring their bicycles

Notes: Food for young (fussy) eaters or persons with special diets can be left in the fridge in your room or in a designated building if it is in a well labelled plastic tub. Use an animal-proof container in cabins. NO NUTS.

## **For Workshops & Worship**

	One candle in a holder for each family
	Bible
	Notebook and pencils or pens
	Any sheet music you may want to use
	Hymn books and other songbooks
	Musical instruments
	Music stand
	Laptop computer (if required)

## **First Aid supplies**

	Bug repellent
	Sunscreen
	Salve for bites and sunburns
	Band-Aids
	Personal medications and a lockable container for them

**Be sure to label everything well so any lost item can be quickly returned.**

## **Other necessary/useful items.**

	<b>Your Camper Guide</b>
	Flashlights and batteries or lantern (some prefer this for reading in cabin)
	Laundry Soap / Dryer Sheets
	Clothes pegs
	Coffee / tea mug
	Refillable Water bottles
	Lawn chairs / camping chairs
	Board Games (for Free Time)
	Children's toys (beach/sand box toys if you have young children)
	Clothes and props for Variety Night (if you already have an act in mind)
	Binoculars for astronomy
	Tape to cover nightlight
	Money for Tuck Shop
	Extra pair of shoes & socks
	Ear plugs (for light sleepers)
	Powerbar or multiplug outlet
	Bin or box for under bed storage
	Donation for PMC Thrift
	Fly Fans for your Table in the dining hall
	WD40 for squeaky hinges

Also: There is electricity in each cabin, so items such as hairdryers, CPAP machines can be used
